Ethics Board Dismisses Katers Complaint...Again *Statement from Senator Cathy Stepp on Rebecca Katers Ethics Filing*

The Wisconsin Ethics Board has dismissed another frivolous complaint against me filed by Rebecca Katers of Green Bay. The Ethics Board has again concluded that I have no conflict of interest with respect to the Job Creation Act, and that I do not stand to benefit from it personally.

In addition to independently verifying that I am not a developer, the Ethics Board director Roth Judd stated "I believe that in every respect Senator Stepp has been truthful and direct in her statements and explanations to the Ethics Board."

I agree with the Mr. Judd's characterization that Ms. Katers' issues are "essentially political in nature." Her latest baseless allegation is a clear attempt to harass me, and destroy my reputation. However, it will not deter me from working to bring jobs to the Racine area, and I will continue to focus my efforts on legislation that moves our economy forward, and gives employers a reason to keep jobs in our communities.
