Toles Sworn In as Newest Assembly Representative *Will work to improve quality of life in 17th Assembly District*

MADISON – Rep. Barbara Toles took the oath of office yesterday to become the Representative for the 17th Assembly District. The Honorable Paul Higginbotham from the 4th District Court of Appeals swore in Rep. Toles.
