A petition to commence an original action having been filed on behalf of petitioners, Mary E. Panzer, et al.; the respondents, James E. Doyle and Marc J. Marotta, having subsequently filed a notice of removal of this case to the United States District Court for the Western District of Wisconsin; the District Court on May 29, 2003 having ordered that the matter be remanded to this court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1447(c) upon its finding that jurisdiction did not lie in that court;

IT IS ORDERED that the petition is reinstated in this court effective the date of this order;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the respondents shall file a response to the petition as filed by June 24, 2003. The response shall (1) include a detailed statement of the facts, if any, the respondents believe are in dispute in this matter and that directly relate to the legal issues raised in the petition; (2) address the effect on the allegations in the petition resulting from any additional compacts, or changes to any of the compacts, since the petition was filed; and (3) address any alleged defenses the respondents would raise in this matter including failure to join indispensable parties.
