(MADISON) State Senate Majority Leader Mary Panzer (R-West Bend) will deliver the Senate Republicans' jobs initiative to Governor Jim Doyle Wednesday morning, September 10 at a breakfast meeting at the Governor's mansion in Maple Bluff.

As part of the breakfast meeting, that also will include Senators Cathy Stepp (R-Racine), Ted Kanavas (R-Brookfield), and Joe Leibham (R-Sheboygan), the Senators will lay out job initiatives, proposed bills and upcoming hearings on legislation created to strengthen the state's economy.

After meeting with the Governor, Senator Panzer and Senate Republicans will hold a press availability, Wednesday at noon in the Senate President's Conference Room at the State Capitol in Madison to provide the media specifics about the Republican jobs plan.

In early June Majority Leader Panzer and Senate Republicans announced the creation of the Select Committee on Job Creation to develop and introduce an economic development and job growth agenda for Wisconsin this fall.
