EXTRAORDINARY SESSION ON JOB CREATION SET

(MADISON) Senate Majority Leader Mary Panzer (R-West Bend) announced today that the Senate would likely come back in extraordinary session to take up the "Job Creation Act of 2003" along with other economic development issues.

"The Senate has been working long hours in negotiations with the Administration to get the job done. We will continue to work long hours to get the job done because it is in the best interest of the citizens of the state of Wisconsin," said Panzer. "We continue with our goal of keeping job creation the No. 1 priority of this session and beyond. We're on a roll, and if the Governor is willing to work with us to push a few additional reforms across the finish line before the end of the year we're willing to work overtime to do it."

Panzer said her goal was to convene the session in the first week of December. The Senate was set to complete its regular floor period this week.
