## **Krug Selected for Joint Committee on Finance**

MADISON – Assembly Democratic Leader Jim Kreuser announced Monday the appointment of Representative Shirley Krug (D-Milwaukee) to the Joint Committee on Finance. The veteran Milwaukee legislator will replace former Representative Spencer Coggs, who was elected to the State Senate on November 18.

“Representative Krug’s experience and hard work make her the best choice for our team,” said Rep. Kreuser. “I am confident that she will serve Assembly Democrats well on this most important committee.”

First elected in 1984, Krug has more seniority in the legislature than any current member of the Finance Committee. She also has previous experience on the budget-writing panel, having served in the early 1990’s.
